It is important to note that neither the Forest Cove community nor the FCPOA have any authority over the golf course.

# TREE WASTE AND JUNK WASTE PROGRAM

On the 2<sup>nd</sup> Wednesday of the month, residents may dispose of their Tree Waste and Junk Waste at the curbside. Tree Waste is collected during ODD numbered months and Junk Waste is collected during EVEN numbered months. Junk Waste may NOT be placed for collection during a Tree Waste month. Trash may be put out between the hours of 6:00 p.m. the Friday before and 7:00 a.m. on the scheduled collection day.

Tree Waste months are January, March, May, July, September, and November.

Tree Waste and Junk Waste months are February, April, June, August, October, and December.

#### FOREST COVE POOL

The Forest Cove Pool, located at 1025 Marina Drive is open. Hours for the pool are Noon to 8:00 pm Tuesday through Sunday, closed Monday for maintenance. On "holiday" Mondays, the pool will remain open and close on Tuesday for maintenance. All residents that have paid their association fees may use the pool. The Board will be adding some shade on the south side. There are Port-o-cans and a hand washing station on location.

The area surrounding the pool is finally taking shape. When the last town home came down, the Houston Parks Board set to work finishing the bike/hike trail. This trail passes right by our pool and community center. Take a bike ride on it soon and enjoy the beauty of the area.

Several residents have asked why bathrooms have not been rebuilt at the pool. We spoke with the City of Houston and were told that FEMA regulations do not allow us to rebuild without significant elevation (approximately 14-16 feet). We plan to provide restrooms as part of the Community Center build back.

If you are building or remodeling your home, adding a shed or fence, replacing a roof, windows or driveway, or building a pool or pool house, you need a permit from the Architectural Control Committee ("ACC"). As a deed restricted community, your plans need to be approved by the ACC. #### 4th OF JULY CELEBRATION 2023

All bicycle riders in the parade must wear helmets. We cannot accommodate ATV's or Go Carts, but Golf Carts will be allowed in the parade with an adult driving. Please provide your own water! Four trophies will be awarded to: Most Patriotic, Best of Theme, Best Bike, and Best Golf Cart.

BBQ will be served on the community center grounds from 12 noon until 2 p.m.—or as long as the brisket lasts.

The meal is free to residents with proof of residency. Non – residents and take out are \$10.00 for Adults and \$5.00 for Children under 10. Tickets will go on sale at 11:45 am at the Gazebo.

Steve Atchison and his crew will be smoking brisket through the night—feel free to join them. We need volunteers tending to the brisket all night. Bring a cooler, snacks, music, etc. and enjoy helping to prepare the meal. Or if you prefer, come down around 7:00 a.m. on the Fourth and slice brisket and sausage.
