This is the day everyone celebrates America! Here is your official invitation to join the Forest Cove festivities. This year's theme is *"Let Freedom Ring"*.

Residents and businesses are invited to enter a float in keeping with the theme. The Parade line-up will begin at 9am at the Community Center on Marina Drive and the parade will start promptly at 10am. Please use Timberline off Hamblen Road for the parade line up. All bicycle riders in the parade must wear helmets per City of Houston ordinance. Unfortunately we cannot accommodate ATV's or go-karts, however golf carts are permitted as long as an adult drives the vehicle.

After winding through beautiful Forest Cove, the parade participants will arrive back at the Community Center for a flag ceremony. Starting at noon to 3pm, we will be serving our famous Forest Cove BBQ at the Community Center, offering eat-in and take-out service.

Menu will include sliced brisket, chopped beef, hot dogs, potato salad, coleslaw, pickles, onion, jalapenos, bread, dessert and of course, cold drinks to wash it all down. Lunch tickets are \$10 for adult and \$5 for kids under 10. We encourage you to join the parade, or watch and wave a flag, then come and sit in the airconditioned community center, while you eat and visit with neighbors. Live music will be played, and door prizes will be won. We'll have games for the kids too.

We'll also open the pool next door for all residents so don't forget your bathing suit, and most importantly, your Forest Cove pool tags. If you haven't already collected your pool tags, you are encouraged to come ahead of time to collect them at the pool office. The pool is for the use of current POA members in good standing – don't forget to bring proof of residence with you when you collect your tags.
